## **Explanation of Terms**

**Source** – Any grant and contract funding source used by the department. This would include competitive grants, special government initiative sources, private sources, etc. Common sources include USDA and its various sub-agencies (ERS, CSREES), USEPA, USAID, nonprofit agencies, and monies from multidisciplinary projects.

**Title** – The title of the project.

**Begin date** – The beginning of the project or time when monies became available for departmental use.

**End date** – The expiration date of the project or time when monies are no longer available for departmental use.

**\$ Received in the Department** – The dollar amount of direct grants and contracts received in the Department.

**Subcontracts (\$) given to other units, universities, etc.** – The dollar amount transferred to other units in your University, other universities, or other contractees.

**\$ Received in other units but used in support of Department** – The dollar amount received by your department from other units in your University, from other universities, or other contractors.

**Competitive?** – Was the grants competitive? The answer can be yes (Y), no (N), or unsure (U).
